The sustainability of the new campus is also a key design consideration, and we aspire to deliver an industry leading sustainable building, with a target of being net zero carbon in operation.

We aim to respond to Elmbridge Borough Council's climate emergency by exploring opportunities to push sustainability and wellbeing design of the building, and provide industry leading headquarters for the building occupants.

Our proposals will aim to:

- Be Net Zero carbon in operation
- Minimise energy consumption
- Include provision of electric vehicle charging points
- Include responsibly-sourced and healthy materials
- Be a 'people first' place that focuses on the health, safety and wellbeing of users and visitors
- Create a space that not only demonstrates our commitment to health and wellbeing, but inspires those who visit and occupy it

Sustainable Travel

GSK is committed to creating a sustainable development where sustainable modes of travel are encouraged among its staff. To help achieve this, complementary shuttle buses will be made available by GSK for all staff who choose to travel by train to nearby Weybridge Station.

A Travel Plan will also be agreed which will include measures aimed at encouraging sustainable travel, such as:

- Cycle parking provision and associated locker & shower facilities.
- Cycling and walking buddies.
- Cycle to work scheme / bike miles scheme
- Liftshare and provision of dedicated car parking bays for car sharing.
- Workshops to promote alternative modes of travel including cycle maintenance workshops and cycle training sessions.
